John the Baptist... Matthew 3:11

SLIDE 4 **Matthew 3:11**

“I (John the Baptist) baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. *He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit* and with fire.

Define the Term...

SLIDE 5 **Define the term... What, Is The Baptism In The Holy Spirit?**

The baptism in the Holy Spirit is an *empowering (enablement) for ministry* that takes place in the life of a believer (Acts 1:5;8). By it we are *immersed (clothed, endued)* in the Spirit's power.

Acts 1:1-5

SLIDE 6 **Acts 1:1-5**

In my former book, Theophilus, I wrote about all that Jesus began to do and to teach² until the day he was taken up to heaven, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles he had chosen.³ After his suffering, he showed himself to these men and gave many convincing proofs that he was alive. He appeared to them over a period of forty days and spoke about the kingdom of God.⁴ On one occasion, while he was eating with them, he gave them this command: “*Do not leave Jerusalem*, but wait for the gift my Father promised, which you have heard me speak about.⁵ For John baptized with water, but in a few days **you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.**”

Acts 1:1-4.... Luke 24:35-39

SLIDE 7 **Luke 24:35-49**

While they were still talking about this, Jesus himself stood among them and said to them, "Peace be with you."³⁷ They were startled and frightened, thinking they saw a ghost.³⁸ He said to them, "Why are you troubled, and why do doubts rise in your minds?³⁹ Look at my hands and my feet. It is I myself! Touch me and see; a ghost does not have flesh and bones, as you see I have."⁴⁰ When he had said this, he showed them his hands and feet.⁴¹ And while they still did not believe it because of joy and amazement, he asked them, "Do you have anything here to eat?"⁴² They gave him a piece of broiled fish,⁴³ and he took it and ate it in their presence.

SLIDE 8 **Luke 24:35-49** Cont.

⁴⁴He said to them, "This is what I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms." ⁴⁵Then he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures. ⁴⁶He told them, "This is what is written: The Christ will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, ⁴⁷and repentance and forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. ⁴⁸You are witnesses of these things. ⁴⁹I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high."

John 20:19-22... another look at this meeting with Jesus

SLIDE 9 **John 20:19-22**

On the evening of that first day of the week, when the disciples were together, with the doors locked for fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you!" ²⁰After he said this, he showed them his hands and side.

The disciples were overjoyed when they saw the Lord.

²¹Again Jesus said, "Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you."

²²**And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit.**

Romans 8:9... no spirit, not saved

SLIDE 10 **Romans 8:9**

You, however, are controlled not by the sinful nature but by the Spirit, if the Spirit of God lives in you. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to Christ.

Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. ⁶Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit."

God puts His Spirit within us and we are "born again" as a child of God.

2 Corinthians 5:17

Therefore, *if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation*; the old has gone, the new has come!

1 Corinthians 6:19

Do you not know that *your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God?* You are not your own;

SLIDE 13 **What happens when we are saved? (Spirit related)**

Ephesians 1:13-15

And you also were included in Christ when you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation. Having believed, you were *marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,* ¹⁴*who is a deposit guaranteeing our inheritance* until the redemption of those who are God's possession—to the praise of his glory.

1 Corinthians 12:13

For we were *all baptized by one Spirit into one body*—whether Jews or Greeks, slave or free—and we were all given the one Spirit to drink.

⁸But **you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you;** and *you will be my witnesses* in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."

Ephesians 5:17-18

Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. ¹⁸Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.

In Us...

Just as the indwelling of the Holy Spirit (that Christians receive when they are saved) reproduces the life of Jesus – In Us

Through Us...

So the Baptism of the Spirit reproduces the ministry (power) of Jesus – Through Us

In Us...

Galatians 5:16-26

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, ²³gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. ²⁴Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the sinful nature with its passions and desires. ²⁵Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.

2 Corinthians 3:17-18

Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is freedom. ¹⁸And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.

Through Us...

SLIDE 20 **Through Us...**

John 14:11-13

Believe me when I say that I am in the Father and the Father is in me; or at least believe on the evidence of the miracles themselves. ¹²I tell you the truth, anyone who has faith in me will do what I have been doing. He will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

Acts 1:8

But *you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses* in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."
